Equatorial Guinea

As of now 315 cases of COVID 19 with one death have been reported in Equatorial Guinea. Among those affected 4 are Indians. Due to evolving pandemic around the world and growing number of cases in Equatorial Guinea, all Indians are requested to continue maintaining social distance and observe measures of hygiene as advised by the World Health Organization (WHO).

• The Vice President of Equatorial Guinea has directed through a notification for a stringent implementation of emergency measures. Emergency measures have been extended till 15.5.2020. Directions of the local government agencies to contain this spread need to be followed. As far as possible, Indians are advised to work from home. Embassy may be kept informed of any infection of COVID 19 in the community.
